

Provo Fire & Rescue offers Community CPR classes to help educate the public and Health Care Providers in the event of an emergency.

Community CPR Certification: Heartsaver CPR / AED

Cost: \$35, Duration: 3 hours

This course teaches adult, child, infant CPR and AED use, as well as how to relieve choking on an adult. This is for anyone with limited or no medical training who needs a CPR / AED card to meet job, regulatory, or other requirements, or for citizens seeking to be prepared in an emergency.

Dates: The first Tuesday of each month (minimum of 6 people required to hold class)
Time: 6:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.
Who Needs It? Police, Fire, Lifeguards, Flight Attendants, Day-Care Providers, CERT Team

Healthcare Provider Course

Cost: \$75, Duration: 4.5 hours

This course is for healthcare professionals who need to know how to perform CPR, as well as other lifesaving skills, in a wide variety of in-hospital and out-of-hospital settings. Student must have a current 2010 student manual purchased prior to class (\$12 for English, \$13.50 for Spanish).

Dates: The first Tuesday of each month (minimum of 6 people required to hold class)
Time: 6:00 p.m. – 10:30 p.m.
Who Needs It? Nurses, Doctors, Physician Assistants, Dentists, EMT's and other health care workers

Heartsaver CPR / AED / First Aid

Cost: \$75, Duration: 6 hours

This course teaches critical skills needed to respond to and manage a first aid, choking or sudden cardiac arrest emergency in the first few minutes until emergency medical services arrive. Students can learn skills such as how to treat bleeding, sprains, broken bones, shock and other first aid emergencies. This course also teaches adult CPR and AED use.

Dates: Taught upon request, with a minimum of 6 students registered
Time: Saturdays: 7:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.
Who Needs It? Police, Fire, Lifeguards, Flight Attendants, Day-Care Providers, CERT Team Members, Fitness Trainers, Massage Therapists

ACLS Provider Course

Initial Cost: \$250, Duration: 10-12 hours

Renewal Cost: \$200, Duration: 5 – 6.5 hours

ACLS is designed for healthcare professionals who either direct or participate in the management of cardiopulmonary arrest and other cardiovascular emergencies. This includes personnel in emergency response, emergency medicine, intensive care and critical care units. Student must have a current 2010 student manual purchased prior to class (\$33.50 for English or Spanish). An on-line pretest is required to be completed prior to class and the test results must be brought to class.

Dates: Taught upon request, with a minimum of 6 students registered
Time: Negotiable
