2011 Fireworks Restrictions

By order of the Provo City Fire Marshal

Due to extremely dry and hazardous conditions, the following local firework restrictions are in effect June 20, 2011 through July, 27, 2011.

It shall be unlawful to discharge any fireworks or other pyrotechnic devices in the following areas:

- All restricted areas within Provo City limits (see map at provo.org for areas of restriction).
- All area of Provo City within 30 feet of combustible weeds, grasses, shrubs, fences, or structures.
- Provo City Parks unless otherwise designated

The following Provo City Parks have been designated for the discharge of legal consumer fireworks:

- Seretoma Park - 2400 North 400 East
- Exchange Park – 900 North 700 West
- Fort Utah Park – 200 North Geneva Road
- Footprinters Park (excluding the ball fields) – 1150 South 1350 West
- **Kiwanis Park – 820 North 1100 East**
- **Provost Park – 629 South 1000 East**

This closure will be aggressively enforced. Violators are subject to the maximum fines allowable under Utah State Law. Violators may also be held civilly liable for any damages caused in violation of this order.

As a reminder, it is unlawful to sell, offer for sale, or discharge fireworks of any kind in the State of Utah outside of those days prescribed by law.

53-7-225. Times for sale and discharge of fireworks.

Class C common state approved explosives may be:

(1) sold each year:

- (a) **beginning on June 26 and ending on July 26;**
- (b) beginning on December 26 and ending on January 1; and
- (c) three days before and on the Chinese New Year; and

(2) discharged each year:

- (a) **beginning on June 26 and ending on July 26;**
- (b) on January 1 and December 31; and
- (c) the day before and on the Chinese New Year.
