

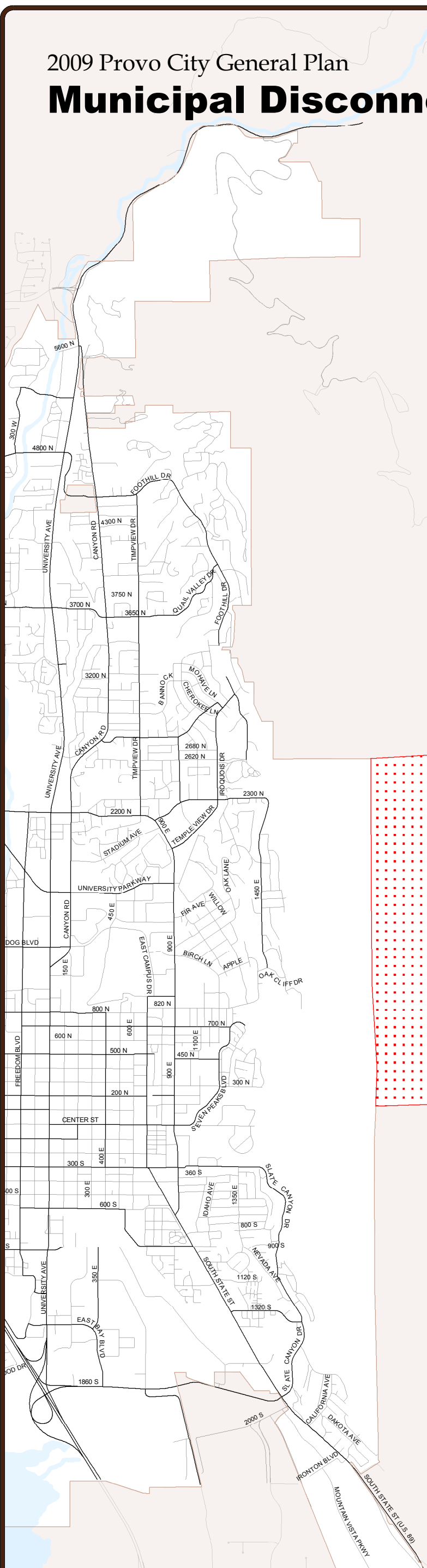
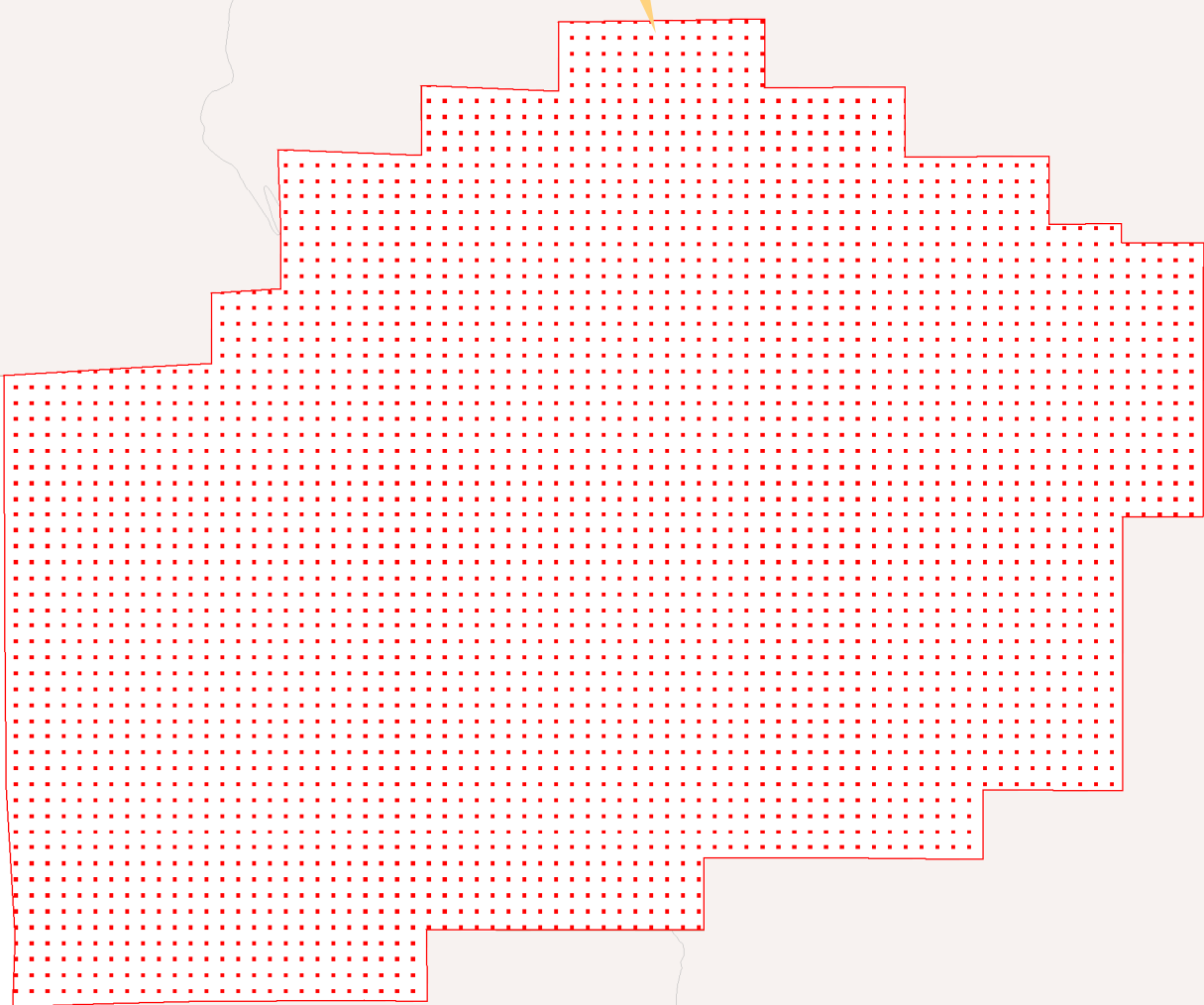

Area Proposed for Disconnection (in red)

Heritage Mountain Ski Area Annexation was annexed into Provo City in 1978 to construct a world class ski resort. After review of the Environmental Impact Statement, the U.S. Forest Service denied the permit, and the facility was never built. Therefore, Provo is proposing a disconnection of 7,035 acres, which is most of the 7,515 acres of the Heritage Mountain Ski Area Annexation.
